College Expectations Volleyball Camp 2018 June 29th – July 1st @ Sweet Briar College

What is a College Expectations Camp? College Expectations Camp is only for the few. Players attending this camp should have the intent to play at the college level. This camp is for varsity level girls only. Players will be asked to execute complex offenses, do whatever it takes to win rallies, show the spirit and teamness needed to play at the next level. If the coaches think the players have the potential to try something, it will be tried!

When/Where? June 29th – July 1st in the Upchurch Field House at Sweet Briar College in Amherst, VA (12 minutes north of Lynchburg, Virginia). The camp begins Friday June 29th at 10am and ends Sunday July 1st around 5pm. Directions can be found on the college website at http://sbc.edu/admissions/directions-campus

There is a one-hour lunch and a one-hour supper break Friday and Saturday. There will be a one-hour lunch break on Sunday. Meals are provided – no additional cost!! The camp will be divided into eight 2 ½ hour sessions over 3 days – a total of 20 hours.

How Many Campers Will Be Accepted? We will guarantee one college-level coach <u>and</u> one assistant per 8 girls. This will allow the player/coach ratio to stay at **4:1**. The camp will be filled on a **first-come**, **first-serve** basis. However, no athlete will be immediately accepted until we are sure the College Expectations Camp is right for her. Applicants who have never attended have four methods to convince us that she's belongs in this camp:

- a) She can have coaches fill out the recommendation forms that are a part of the application. They are below.
- b) She can send us video of her playing;
- She is known by a coach who has experience at an Expectations Camp, and that coach gives a positive recommendation to Coach Houser, or;
- d) She is known or can be seen playing by Coach Houser.

If an athlete chooses the 2 recommendations, then we ask that one of them be filled out by this season's school coach. The other can be a previous coach or club team coach. These letters may be mailed with the registration form or sent separately. They may also be scanned and emailed to coachhouser@yahoo.com Coach Houser's mailing address is: Tom Houser, 6023 Marsh Wren Lane, Roanoke, Va 24018. → For The Returners! Players who attended High or College Expectations camp last year do not need to have ANY recommendation letters! Just fill out the registration form (page 2 below), mail it in with deposit, and the parents will be contacted promptly! ⑤ If an athlete attended College Exp in 2017, she will almost assuredly be accepted again in 2018. However, an athlete who attended a previous High Expectations camp isn't guaranteed admittance into 2018 College Expectations. We will assign her to the camp that we are sure will be a positive experience or her and her camp teammates.

Registration Is Not Considered Complete until Coach Houser has received all of the necessary forms. A confirmation email will be sent when he receives the registration form, the recommendations, and the deposit. Another email will be sent for acceptance/denial.

Cost? \$349, which will include all meals listed above. A \$149, nonrefundable deposit will hold your spot, pending acceptance.

- * If an athlete isn't accepted into College Expectations, the deposit will be refunded.

Who Can Register? The goal for the College Expectations Camp is to only accept girls who are at least rising 9th graders, and who have at least 5 seasons of competitive playing experience. "Seasons" include both school and club teams. A "season" isn't summer league, County League, a YMCA team, a double league, etc. We may make a few exceptions. Last summer we made 1 total exception in High and College. If an athlete doesn't have the requisite experience, but believes that she should be considered anyway, please contact us!

Camp T-shirt – Camp t-shirts will be given out on the first day of camp!

Overnight camper – Please add an additional \$49 per day to stay overnight at the Elston Inn & Conference Center (hotel is on the campus of Sweet Briar College) If a girl wishes to stay two nights, then the total cost for the camp would be \$448. Breakfast will be provided at the motel each morning. All rooms will be triples or quads, unless an athlete is assigned a room with a staff member. Please tell me on the form below who the athlete prefers to room with. If parents or coaches would like reserve a room at the Elston Inn, please contact the hotel at (434) 381-6207.
